## LUKE 1

### Luke 1:1-4 — Introduction

1:3 — For whom did Luke write his “account of the things that have been fulfilled among us” (verse 1)?

**Acts 1:1-2** — To whom is the book of Acts addressed? \_\_\_\_\_ This connection to Luke 1:3 is how we know that Acts was written by Luke, and that it was intended as a sequel to Luke’s first book.

### Luke 1:5-25 — An Angel Foretells the Birth of John

**Date** — Herod the Great (1:5) ruled Judea under Roman authority in the years 37-4 BC. These events took place almost at the end of that period, probably around 7 or 6 BC.

### Luke 1:26-38 — An Angel Foretells the Birth of Jesus

### **Luke 1:39-56 — Mary Visits Elizabeth; Mary's Song**

1:42-45 — What blessings did Elizabeth speak upon Mary?

1:46-55 — What are 2 or 3 aspects of God's character that Mary celebrates in her song of praise?

**Matthew 1:18-25** — *The announcement of Jesus' birth, from Joseph's perspective:* What was Joseph planning to do when he found out Mary, his fiancé, was pregnant (and not by him)?

- Who convinced Joseph to take Mary as his wife?
- Matthew (1:22-23) tells us these events fulfilled a prophecy from Isaiah 7:14 (from 700 years earlier) concerning a child who would be called \_\_\_\_\_, meaning "\_\_\_\_\_ with us".

### **Luke 1:57-80 — John Is Born; Zechariah's Song**

**Background** — *Mary's song and Zechariah's song are spoken in the tradition of Hannah's song (1 Samuel 2:1-10). Hannah, an Israelite, lived about 1,000 years before Mary & Zechariah. Like them, she was childless until God caused her to conceive; like their sons, her son Samuel grew up to be a prophet for the Lord.*
