Summit View Church of Christ PHASE 3 CHANGES

Our county and region have finally made it to Phase 3!

Here are the Phase 3 changes we're making:

- **UP TO 15 PEOPLE MAY SIT TOGETHER**, per the state's guidelines. Use your discretion about whether to sit with a friend or another family during worship. Limiting groups to only one or two households is preferred, but not required.
- **SEATING OF UP TO 50% CAPACITY IS ALLOWED IN EACH ROOM.** This comes out to 225 people for our sanctuary.
- **CONGREGATIONAL SINGING IS PERMITTED.**

Most Phase 3 guidelines require that we continue to do what we're already doing to minimize virus spread during our assemblies:

- Wear a mask.
- Sit at least 6 feet apart from other groups.
- Stay home if you're at high risk of serious infection if you were to catch COVID-19. Stay home if you have possible COVID-19 symptoms.
- We will continue to take each person's temperature upon arrival, keep a record of attendance, and provide individual cup-and-wafer containers for Communion.
- About 225 people may be present at in-person worship in our sanctuary. We have not yet reached this limitation on a Sunday; we still have ample space for those who are able to return to in-person worship.
- No contribution baskets will be passed. You may deposit your offering in the bird house in the foyer, make an electronic deposit from the church's website (www.summitviewchurch.net), or mail it to the church office.

More details:

- **WHAT'S OPEN** — restrooms, the nursery
- **WHAT'S CLOSED** — Bible classes, classrooms, the toddler room (Room 3), drinking fountains
- Worship services will continue to run about an hour instead of our traditional 90 minutes to limit our virus exposure until COVID-19 infection rates drop further.

We've had a frustrating year, but we also have much to be grateful for. Thank you so much for your flexibility and patience as we navigate this pandemic. Thanks for so faithfully practicing the instruction of Philippians 2:3-4, "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others."
