# SPEAKERS

## DR. KEITH STANGLIN

is Professor of Historical Theology at Harding School of Theology and Executive Director of the Center for Christian Studies in Austin, Texas. He is also editor of the *Journal of Christian Studies*. Among his interests are moral theology and how ethics informs and guides the Christian life. He is the author of several books, including *Ethics Beyond Rules: How Christ's Call to Love Informs Our Moral Choices* (Zondervan Reflective, 2021). Dr. Stanglin presented on "Engaging Calvinism" at the Expositor's Seminar in 2018.



## DR. ALLEN BLACK

is Professor of New Testament Emeritus and former Dean at Harding School of Theology. He is the author of commentaries on the Gospel of Mark and, with his brother Mark Black, on the letters of 1 and 2 Peter (The College Press NIV Commentary Series). Dr. Black spoke at the Expositor's Seminar on the topic of the Gospel of Luke in 2012. He has spoken on topics ranging from the Gospel of John to living a holy life in an unholy world.
