### LUKE 22-23, Part 2 (22:39 to 23:12)

#### Review

Jesus' ministry prior to his suffering is complete. He has taught, he has healed, he has driven out demons, he has worked miracles, he has nurtured faith in his disciples, he has declared the kingdom of God throughout the land of Israel. Now he knows he is about to be betrayed (Luke 22:21-22); he knows his suffering, including crucifixion, is about to begin (recall his predictions and hints of his suffering in 9:22, 9:44, 13:33, 18:31-33, 22:19-20, 22:34, 22:37).

#### Luke 22:39-46 — Jesus Prays on the Mount of Olives

22:40 — Jesus twice (again in verse 46) urged his disciples to pray that they would not...

22:42 — Jesus, a short distance from his disciples, prayed, "Father, if you are willing, \_\_\_\_\_; yet not \_\_\_\_\_, but \_\_\_\_\_ be done."

22:43 — What happened, so that Jesus was strengthened?

22:44 — What sign of Jesus' anguish does Luke note here as Jesus continues to pray?

#### Luke 22:47-53 — Jesus Is Betrayed and Arrested

- 22:66 — At what time did this gathering and questioning of Jesus take place?
- 22:67-69 — The Jewish leaders said, “If you are the \_\_\_\_\_, tell us.” Jesus answered, “If I tell you, you will not \_\_\_\_\_ me, and if I asked you, you would not \_\_\_\_\_.” (Recall how they did just that in 20:1-8.)
