## LUKE 24

### Review

Fulfilling words of the ancient prophets and of Jesus himself, Jesus has now been betrayed, mistreated, crucified, and buried. He died Friday afternoon and was buried before sunset that evening. Over the Sabbath weekend, his body rested in the tomb. But the women who followed him had not had sufficient time before the Sabbath to honor his body with spices and perfumes in the traditional way, so now, on Sunday morning, they return to Jesus' tomb.

### Luke 24:1-12 — The Empty Tomb
