## LUKE 2

### Luke 2:1-21 — The Birth of Jesus

**date:** *Caesar Augustus ruled the Roman Empire 27 BC to AD 14. Quirinius governed the Roman province of Syria (including Galilee and Judea) twice, we think: in 6-4 BC and again in AD 6-7. He apparently conducted a census in both of his terms. Herod the Great ruled Judea under the Roman emperor from 37 BC until his death in 4 BC. Based on the chronology provided by Matthew and Luke, Jesus was born around 6-5 BC.*

### Luke 2:22-40 — Prophecy at the Dedication of Jesus

2:22-24 — *Mary and Joseph observe two separate but connected rituals here. One is for Mary's purification—read **Leviticus 12**. The other is for the dedication of her firstborn to God—read **Exodus 13:1-2**.*

- *According to Leviticus 12, how old would Jesus have been when Joseph & Mary went to the temple for their son's dedication and for Mary's purification?* \_\_\_\_\_
