# Acts 6:1-7 Highlights:

- 6:1 The \_\_\_\_\_\_ Jewish widows were being overlooked in the daily distribution of food.
- How might a church today face a problem of unequal treatment of two ethnic groups or socio-economic groups in the congregation? Give an example.
- 6:4 The apostles needed to focus their attention on \_\_\_\_\_\_ and the ministry of the \_\_\_\_\_\_
- Who did the Twelve think they were? Were they too good to "wait on tables" (take care of getting food to the church's widows)? Why did they give this responsibility to others? Did they do the right thing or not?

### **STEPHEN'S DEFENSE SPEECH**

- Throughout his speech, Stephen highlights the work of God through people honored by Jews everywhere: Abraham, Joseph, and Moses. But Joseph and Moses had faced opposition from their own people...
- 7:2-8 *from Genesis 12-35* setting the stage with how God called \_\_\_\_\_\_ to go to the promised land and began to make him the father of Israel (the Jewish people)
- 7:9-16 from Genesis 37, 39-50 \_\_\_\_\_ was sold as a slave by his own brothers, but God used him to save his family (the ancestors of the Jews) from a \_\_\_\_\_.
- 7:17-29 *from Exodus 1-2* \_\_\_\_\_ was brought up in the household of the Egyptian pharaoh, but when God began to use him to rescue his fellow Israelites from slavery, his own people rejected him.

7:30-43 — from Exodus 3-32, plus references from throughout the history of Israel — Beginning at the burning \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, God sent \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to be Israel's leader; this man led Israel for \_\_\_\_\_\_ years...but the Israelites still turned away from him and from God!
7:44-50 — The early Israelites had the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ and the later Israelites had God's \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ (the temple)—but God doesn't live in houses made by human hands!
7:51-53 — Like their ancestors, the current Jewish leaders are resisting the Holy Spirit by betraying and murdering \_\_\_\_\_\_ and by refusing to believe in him (though Moses himself had foretold his coming, Acts 7:37 quoting Deuteronomy 18:15).

**THE KEY TO STEPHEN'S DEFENSE SPEECH** is a warning from Israel's history: As the Jews' ancestors had rejected their God-chosen leaders in the past (Joseph's brothers rejected him, the Israelites rejected Moses), so the Jews had now rejected God's chosen Messiah, Jesus. In doing so, they were resisting the work of the Holy Spirit himself! On top of this sinful act, the Jews were valuing the temple of God over God himself: they were accusing Stephen of speaking against the temple (6:13-14), but they themselves were standing against Jesus the Messiah! Though they have the temple, they "have betrayed and murdered" Jesus the Righteous One (7:52-53). Stephen's implication here is that it is not he who has blasphemed God, but <u>his opponents</u>, through their rejection and killing of Jesus.


