### 2 Kings 24:1b-4

- Jehoiakim had become king of Judah in 609 BC. He became Nebuchadnezzar's vassal when the Babylonians took control of Jerusalem and Judah in 605 BC. Three years later he broke his treaty with Nebuchadnezzar.

• From Babylonian records we know that Jehoiakim was captured (and so his son became king of Judah) on December 9, 598 BC.
